EXAM COMPLAINT INFO SHEET

You **CANNOT** complain about a grade. You can complain about the **CONDUCT** of the exam within **2 WEEKS** of the grade being announced.

The organisation may include for example:

- Not enough time during the exam
- Incorrect invitation to the commission exam
- Complications in the exam process

> Couldn't find a solution? You can escalate your complaint further

Escalation to Head of Studies

Send your **written** complaint to the head of your academic programme within **2 weeks**. Refer to the paragraph in the statutes: "In accordance with section 10 of the statutes of the FH Upper Austria" in order to be legally and formally protected.

Document: Section 10 - FH Upper Austria Statutes

The head of your academic programme / course can accept or reject your complaint.

Decision on the complaint

The head of your academic programme / course must provide you feedback on the decision and give you the **opportunity to object**.

If the decision on your complaint is **negative**, you

can submit an **official objection** in step 4.

Once you have received feedback, you have either been proven right or you can submit an objection.

Objection to the Academic Board

You can submit your **official objection** in **written form** to the FH Upper Austria Academic Board within **2 weeks** of receiving your feedback. The Academic Board will contact the Dean's Office of your campus and instruct them to find a solution. You will be informed about this.
